WHO WE ARE

Youth Stop AIDS (YSA) is a UK-based, youth-led movement campaigning on issues surrounding HIV and AIDS.

Power

As a network of University and regional-based groups, we have a firm belief in the power of young people to make change in the world and we strive to support and upskill young people in their campaigning.

Passion

We are fuelled by a passion to end AIDS by 2030, in line with Sustainable Development Goal 3, and believe that it is immoral and unjust to ignore the issues surrounding HIV and AIDS. We fight for LGBTQ+ rights and the rights of key and vulnerable populations.

Activism

Our campaigning consists of three main aims: zero new HIV transmissions, zero HIV related stigma and discrimination and zero AIDS-related deaths. To achieve these aims we campaign and lobby, our activism being carried out across many levels, from university campuses to Parliamentary meetings. We lobby in three main areas – for access to medicines for all, for continued funding in the global response to HIV and AIDS, and in advocacy of human rights.

As a campaigner you will:



Take direct action

Stunts, protests and demonstrations are great for grabbing the attention of the media and the people making the decisions we want to influence. Our campaigners run their own local publicity actions and take part in nationally organised stunts too.



Lobby

We train our campaigners so that they feel confident to attend meetings with their elected MPs (Member of Parliament) and MSPs (Member of Scottish Parliament), either in their Constituency or in Parliament itself.



Spread the word

We reach out to the public to increase awareness of the problems around HIV and AIDS and change negative attitudes towards people affected by HIV. We get their support for our public campaigns, gathering signatures for action cards, petitions, taking photographs, and speaking out online on social media and traditional media too.



Organise locally

As individuals or as part of a network, we hold film screenings, fundraise and reach out to community, youth and HIV & AIDS groups.
